2017 SCHOLARSHIP FUND APPLICATION

The Homeowner's Rehab, Inc & Cambridge Neighborhood Apartment Housing Services, Inc. Scholarship Fund was established in 2008 to provide financial assistance to residents of all Homeowner's Rehab and Cambridge Neighborhood Apartment Housing Services-owned properties who are pursuing higher education. Scholarship applicants are eligible to receive assistance for the full term of their education at a two or four year accredited, degree-awarding institution.

Priority will be given to programs with IN CLASS curriculums. Online courses will be given less consideration. Course load will factor into award amount. Awards are expected to be a <u>minimum</u> of \$500; the maximum award is \$4000.

In some cases, awards will be bifurcated between fall and spring. Applicants will need to display academic proficiency in order to receive the 2^{nd} half of the award. Applicants with bifurcated scholarships will be disqualified from receiving the 2^{nd} half of their award if students fail to maintain a minimum GPA requirement, receive any Ds or Fs on their fall semester transcripts or retake the same class twice in one academic year.

All applications are subject to review by the scholarship committee whose decisions are final and nonnegotiable.

Eligibility Requirements:

In order to be eligible for the Homeowner's Rehab, Inc & Cambridge Neighborhood Apartment Housing Services, Inc. Scholarship Fund, the following requirements must be met:

- Must reside in a rent-assisted apartment in a Homeowner's Rehab, Inc or Cambridge Neighborhood Apartment Housing Services, Inc. property
- Must be attending or have received admittance to a two or four year accredited, degree-awarding institution of higher achievement
- Demonstrated financial need
- Demonstrated academic promise and achievement
- There is **no age limit** for scholarship applicants

Application Submission Documents:

- Completed application form
- Transcript of grades from high school or college
- Proof of acceptance (acceptance letter/verification of enrollment)
- Current letter of recommendation from a teacher/supervisor
- Copy of financial aid award letter from college
